INTRODUCTION

Participants will gain hands-on experience in fire extinguisher handling, CPR and choking management, workplace evacuation procedures, as well as the fundamentals of Emergency Response Team (ERT) and Incident Command System (ICS).

Through interactive learning and a combined emergency drill, this course enhances coordination, communication and real-time decision-making during emergencies. Suitable for all levels of staff, the programme aims to build confidence, awareness and readiness to respond effectively to workplace emergencies.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

By completing the course, participants will be able to:

- Understand fire behaviour, fire hazards and fire classes.
- Operate fire extinguishers safely and effectively.
- Perform CPR, choking management and basic first aid.
- Apply workplace evacuation procedures and ERT/ICS roles.
- Demonstrate skills through tabletop drills and a combined emergency exercise.
